Parents and guardians,

The Governor has extended our return date to no sooner than Wednesday April 8th.

We would like offer our students the opportunity to continue working on their classes from home. This is suggested, but is not mandatory. Students may log on by going to www.Edgenuity.com. Staff will be logging on periodically throughout each day to check student work as well as emails from students and parents.

1. Students should be able to complete 3 quizzes/tests (at 60% or higher) or to log in and work for a minimum of 3 hours. Students should feel free to set this as a daily goal for themselves.
2. Any academic questions will be addressed through Edgenuity email.
3. If a student completes a class, the teacher will contact the counselor and a new class will be assigned.
4. It is not mandatory that students work from home. This is simply an opportunity for students to do work while Lincoln School is not in session.
5. Comcast is offering free internet to families in need during this time for any student that does not have Internet access.
